Each Memory Light is built once, for one family. We work directly from your program cover (or a photo, name, and memorial text if a program isn't ready yet) and the online obituary link — no separate typing or formatting required on your end. What arrives is finished: no assembly, no setup, no tag left blank.

Send the program cover (or photo + name/text) and the obituary link.

We 3D-print the panel, program the NFC tag, and assemble the unit.

Delivered within 48 hours — fully finished, ready to place.

Turnaround — 48 hours from receiving the program cover (or photo + text) and obituary link. Ask about further rush timing for services on very short notice.



Mini Tap

A compact, reusable NFC card or stand for the guest table — ordered in bulk, kept on hand, and reprogrammed by your own staff before each service.

Mini Tap isn't tied to any one family, so it isn't made to order the way Memory Light is — you keep a small stock on hand and reprogram it yourself in under a minute, any smartphone, no app required. A single tap opens your digital sign-in or condolence page, replacing the shared pen and paper guest book.

WHY IT WORKS

A Margin-Ready Add-On

Sits next to what you already sell — urns, prayer cards, jewelry. Families want something to hold; you have a new line to offer without changing how you sell.

Memory Light arrives finished and programmed. Mini Tap takes under a minute to reprogram. Nothing for your staff to host, install, or maintain.

QUESTIONS YOU'RE LIKELY TO ASK

Q — What if the family doesn't have a printed program yet?

A — We can build Memory Light from a photo plus the name and memorial text directly, and the obituary link — no program cover required.

Q — What if there's no online obituary live yet?

A — The NFC tag needs a live link to program correctly, so we'll need the obituary page published before we can finalize that piece — the light box and panels can still be produced in the meantime.

Q — How long does a Memory Light order take to arrive?

A — 48 hours from when we have the program cover (or photo + text) and the obituary link. Ask about further rush options if a service is on very short notice.

Q — What happens if a name or detail is misprinted?

A — Flag it as soon as it's noticed and we'll correct and reprint the panel — confirming the name, dates, and text with you before production avoids this in the first place.

Q — Does Mini Tap work on every guest's phone?

A — Nearly all modern smartphones support NFC tap natively. Each unit also ships with a printed QR code as a fallback for anyone whose phone doesn't read the tap.

Q — Can we reprogram a Mini Tap ourselves without help?

A — Yes — that's the design. A free how-to card (or short video) walks any staff member through it; it takes under a minute with a standard smartphone, no app install required.

Q — Is there a minimum order or ongoing fee?

A — No monthly fee on either product. Memory Light is priced per unit; Mini Tap has volume pricing but no subscription — you own what you buy.

Q — Can the light box or panels be swapped or updated later?

A — Panels can be reordered if a family wants an additional photo produced later. The light box itself is reusable across panel changes.
